**Call to order**

It was decided there was not enough information from fall quarter to determine if the Bistro should have modified hours. Jocelyn Matheny mentioned hearing positive feedback about the new late hours. It was decided that winter quarter would be 24/7 and it will be evaluated at the end of the quarter to determine the hours of the Bistro. The council will need to see, sales information, student feedback, and laptop usage data before making a permanent decision.
