#### **Call to order**

The meeting was called to order at 1:02pm by the Cahir, Lwin Htet.

#### **Funding Request: Help Desk- Secure W2: \$6,634**

The ITS help desk is asking the council to renew the Secure W2 license, the council has paid for this since 2019. The council agrees this software is necessary to help students connect their devices to the network on campus.

#### **VDI Costs**

The council is not comfortable with fully funding the monthly VDI costs because of how expensive it is. They want the 4 colleges to contribute based on their usage. Mike Marchand sent the council how much each college uses and how much it would cost. Lwin is going to create a draft email and send it to the council for review before sending out to the colleges. The email will ask colleges to participate in the monthly funding for VDI based on their usage.

#### **Wepa Contract**

The 1-year contract with Wepa is ending and the council needs to decide whether or not they should extend for 6 months or set into a 3-year contract. Stacy talked about the pros and cons of continuing Wepa and the council agreed that the pros outweighed the cons. If the Wepa printers were to leave, the cost of going back to the old way would be too time consuming and expensive. The council is interested in the 3-year contract but want to make sure the current printing costs would remain the same. Bea will reach out to Wepa and get more answers.

#### **Other**

The council was informed that the Student Tech Fee was reinstated for Spring Quarter, it is back to \$30 per full-time student.
